Don McPherson is a long term resident of Tumbler Ridge, initially working as a contractor for Quintette Coal and subsequently going into business for himself as the owner / operator of the local Shell Gas Station, a company that he successfully ran for 18 years.



After selling the gas station, he ventured into the oil and gas sector as a contractor and also started a successful river boat tour business.

Don's lengthy public service reflects his dedication to both the Peace River Region and the community of Tumbler Ridge – having seen the latter go through dramatic economic swings and currently overseeing the community's economic diversification into other sectors, particularly tourism.”
