Rob Fraser, Mayor of the District of Taylor has been a resident of northeastern BC for 38 years; 12 years in Fort Nelson, 3 years in Fort St. John and since 1992, a resident of Taylor.

He was first elected as a Councillor for the District in 1993 and served four terms until 2006, when he left local government to pursue personal business interests. Rob was elected as Mayor of the District of Taylor in November 2014. He was appointed to represent Taylor on the Regional District Board in December 2014. During the inaugural meeting, the Board elected Rob as vice-chair.



As well as serving the District of Taylor as a Councillor then as the Mayor, Rob's background includes owning an occupation health and safety business for sixteen years, working for the Workers' Compensation Board of BC for ten years and working in the upstream petroleum industry for ten years.
