

Peace River Regional District Water Stewardship Committee Terms of Reference

ROLE OF THE COMMITTEE

- With the understanding that water is essential to life, the goal of the Water Stewardship Committee is to provide a sustainable long term view to the health, use, management, and enhancement of water resources in the Peace River Regional District.
- 2. To deliberate and provide comment on the issues of a water nature, that are referred by resolution of the Regional Board, such as enhanced opportunities to promote water conservation and sustainability.
- 3. Provide recommendations on emerging water issues such as, but not limited to:
 - inventory of ground water and data;
 - competing water interests;
 - water protection;
 - understanding regulations, compliance/enforcement of water allocation and use.

STRUCTURE OF THE COMMITTEE

A. Members:

- The Committee will consist of Board members as appointed by the Board;
- The meetings will be chaired by a Committee member elected by the Committee participants;
- Appropriate Regional District staff person non-voting.

B. Meetings

- Meetings will be at the call of the Committee Chair as necessary;
- Meetings will be open to the public;
- Items for the regular agenda must be provided to Administration 1 week prior to the scheduled meeting.

PROCEDURES

- **Quorum:** At least one-half of the members of the Committee;
- Voting: All recommendations that come before the Committee shall be determined by way of majority vote;
- Recommendations: The Committee is advisory to the PRRD Board and all recommendations will be forwarded to the Regional Board for consideration and action.
