RCMP Priorities for Rural areas of the PRRD

The Board supported the 2017-2018 Policing priorities identified by the RCMP in the Peace River Regional District as follows:

Chetwynd Detachment- Violence – Domestic Violence – Awareness Initiatives, Traffic – Speeding, Drugs and Alcohol Abuse

Tumbler Ridge Detachment-Traffic – Impaired Driving, Speeding, ATV/Snowmobiles, Property - Crime Reduction

Hudson’s Hope Detachment- Crime Reduction: Reducing Property Crime, Crime Reduction: Reducing Total Number of Criminal Code Offences, Crime Reduction: Reducing Violent Crime in Northern British Columbia, Enhance Road Safety: Impaired Driving, Increased Visibility/Enforcement, Community Engagement – Youth/Community

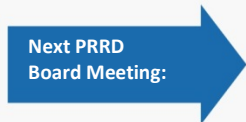
