 "Oil and Gas Activities Act - An Introduction" Mike Lambert, Executive Director, Oil and Gas Division, Ministry of Energy, Mines and Petroleum Resources joined the meeting via conference call to give a presentation on the *Oil and Gas Activities Act* (OGAA), particularly the Environmental Protection and Management Regulation.

The OGAA passed in May of 2008, but legislation is not in force until the regulations which have been under development since February 2009, are complete. Presently consultations are being undertaken with stakeholders and local government. May 2010 is the Ministry's target date for completion.

A question and answer period ensued with the following points discussed:

- this is the time to make comments and recommendations:
- a regulatory team is being put in place this winter;
- pre-permit regulations will allow for lots of local government input;
- the importance of the industry applicant knowing what the key values are;
- there will be a 15 day allowance period to appeal after an agreement has been reached between industry and the landowner;
- transitions regulations will be put in place;
- training sessions are occurring in Dawson Creek and Fort St. John;
- clarification was given of the difference between reserve and riparian management zones;
- when the mediation / arbitration board would come into play;
- there will be stand alone set back regulations for oil and gas activity around schools:

- there needs to be more emphasis on the protection of water sheds;

Rich McCrae, Curator of Palaeontology, and Lisa Buckley, Collections Manager of the Peace Region Palaeontology Research Centre in Tumbler Ridge, BC were in the meeting in response to the Board's invitation to provide an update on the exciting news of their recent discovery of a complete dinosaur in the BC Peace Region.

BC has already been recognised for its track ways of dinosaur footprints and also for its finds of disarticulated bones, but never before for a complete dinosaur. The excavation ran for four weeks in 2008 where only isolated bones were found. Further digging in 2009 exposed the fossilized skeleton buried forward into a side hill with its tail portion exposed to the outer edge of the bank. The excavators were delighted to find the back bone articulated and well preserved. So far, the vertebras, from in front of the hip all the way back to the mid point of the tail, have been uncovered, jacketed and taken to the research centre in Tumbler Ridge. With the assistance of helicopter support in 2010, the expectation is to finish the excavation within two to three months. After that, it should take a year of work to get it ready for displaying in the Tumbler Ridge Centre.

The Palaeontologists are building up the province's only repository for vertebrates, where any researcher with interest can come in to study the artefacts. The information gleaned, some from graduates from the University of Alberta, is incorporated into the local research centre's resources.

Director White complimented the delegation on their widely respected efforts, which have resulted in the provincial government getting involved to look at ways to manage the province's fossil resources.

Prior to leaving the meeting, the Palaeontologists presented the Board with a mounted replica of the left radius of the Hadrosaur, British Columbia's first complete dinosaur.
