2020 Cleanup Coupons

Each year, the Peace River Regional District mails out free cleanup coupons that let residents take four free loads per year at any PRRD landfill or Tier 1 and 2 Transfer Stations. Make sure you check what items are accepted at your nearest landfill/Transfer Station before taking your load.

Who gets cleanup coupons?

Cleanup Coupons are available for all properties within the PRRD, which includes both rural and municipal residents. There is a limit of one coupon per household.

When can I expect to receive my coupons?

Cleanup Coupons are sent by mail in the spring to all households in the PRRD who used their cleanup coupons the year before. Coupons for this year can be used from May 1st, 2020 to April 30th, 2021.

What do I do if I did not receive my coupons?

If you did not receive your cleanup coupons, you can request that they be mailed to your address or picked up at a PRRD Office.

Connectivity Needs Survey

The Peace River Regional District faces unique challenges with connectivity in the electoral areas. The Peace River Regional District (PRRD) has hired Valo Networks and Canadian Fiber Optics Corporation to complete a connectivity needs assessment for the electoral areas of the PRRD. This includes making an inventory of existing networks, mapping locations of existing fiber, and identifying areas where there is no service. The survey results will inform the Regional Connectivity Needs Assessment.
