The services offered through the program are delivered by the Dawson Creek Society for Community Living (DCSCL). The services include freshly frozen meals delivered each week, housekeeping and snow removal from November to March.

PRRD FireSmart program helping seniors throughout the region

In addition to helping rural residents around the region take a proactive approach to wildfire preparedness, the Peace River Regional District (PRRD) is proud to offer support for seniors and persons with mobility issues through the FireSmart program this year.

So far this year, the FireSmart crew has worked with 60 senior households to provide essential wildfire risk mitigation activities such as tree pruning, grass and brush clearing, gutter cleaning and other critical landscaping jobs. The program is funded through the provincial government, managed by the PRRD and implemented by local contractor, Mammoth Forestry.

The FireSmart program has assisted over 400 rural properties since it began in 2021. Each year, the crew provides over 100 residents with expert advice on how to protect their home from wildfire. FireSmart Home Ignition Consultations are free, private and confidential and open to all rural residents in the Peace River region!
