## EVACUATION ALERT #12

### Donnie Creek/Tommy Lakes Wildfire

#### Electoral Area B

June 19, 2023 at 16:30 hours

An Evacuation Alert has been issued by the Peace River Regional District. BC Wildfire Service has recommended this Alert due to the potential danger to life and health caused by the Donnie Creek/Tommy Lakes wildfire. Evacuation Alert #12 replaces Alert #11.

The Evacuation Alert applies to an area boundary described as:

- From Mile 207 on Highway 97 North West to the Prophet River
- Southwest following the Prophet River for 14km to Milliken Creek
- From that point, continuing south easterly, maintaining approximately a 6 km buffer west of Hwy 97 N to a point of intersection of km 20 on the Pink Mountain Road (Halfway River)
- South east following Halfway River to the intersection of Boring Ranch Road and Cypress Creek Road
- South east and east to a point of intersection with Highway 97 N at km 177
- Heading north along Highway 97 to 1 km north of Tommy Lakes Road
- Turning north east within 1 km of the Tommy Lakes Road for 20 km
- From there heading due east to PDR 200 (North of Peejay)
- Turning north for 20 km
- Heading due west towards a point 6 km before mile 160 on the Alaska Highway
- Turning northeast along the Sikanni Chief River for 4 km
- Heading northwest for 44 km
- Then southeast towards Kirkpatrick Creek
- Then generally northeast towards Horse Range Creek
- Then northwest to Mile 207 to the Prophet River

An Evacuation Alert is issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however, you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

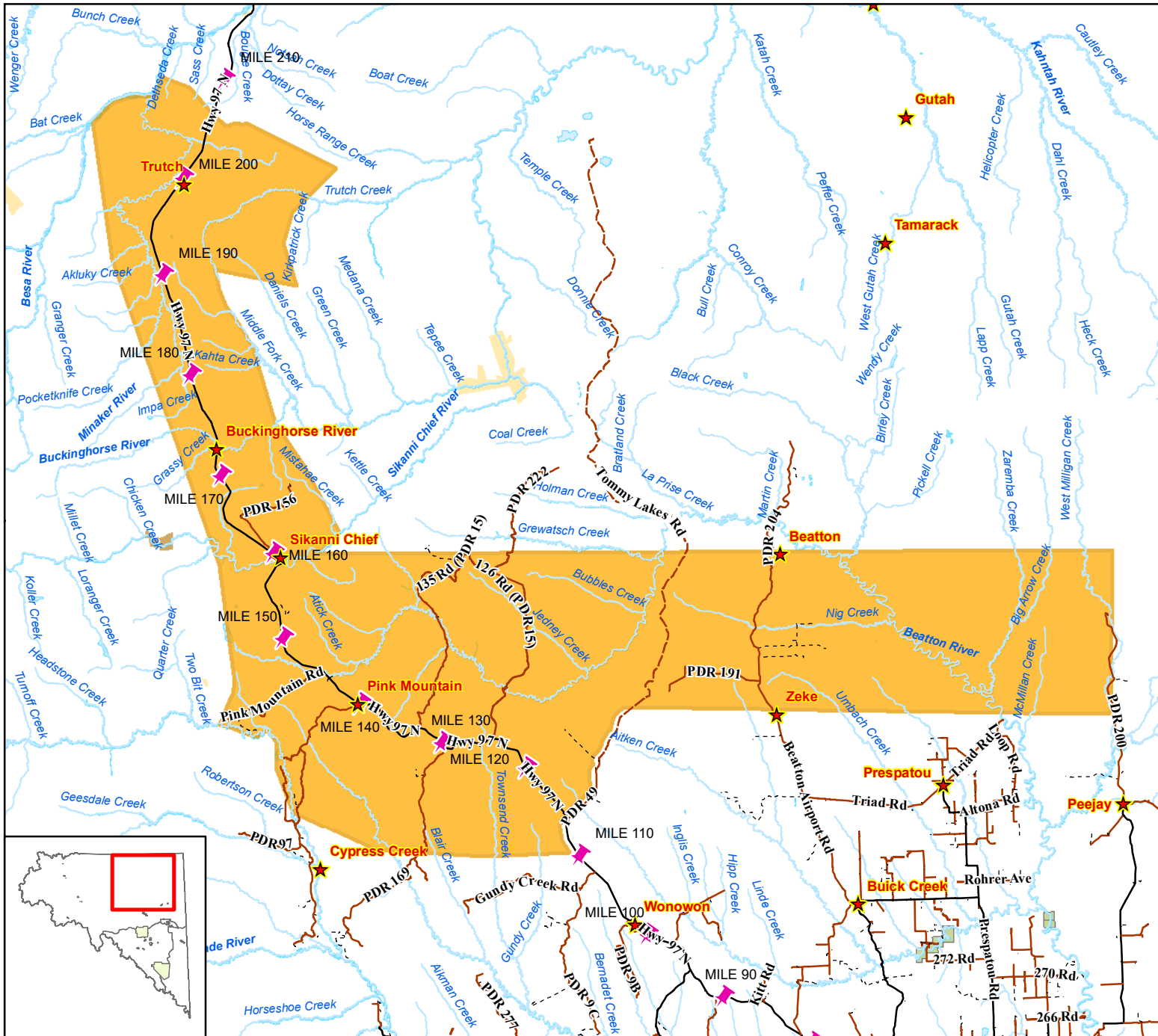
- Locate all family members and designate a meeting area outside the evacuation area in case an Evacuation Order is called while you are separated.
- Pack essential items for a quick departure, such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g., insurance, passports, birth certificates, banking and mortgage information), immediate care needs for dependents, cellphone and charger and, if time and space permits, personal keepsakes.
- Prepare to move people with disabilities, children and neighbours if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets and pet care items (leash, carrier, food) with you.
- Make a plan for livestock, including moving livestock to a safe area (if possible).
- Ensure your cistern or potable water system is full.
- Arrange transportation for all your household members. Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles.
- If you will need assistance to evacuate from the area, such as for transportation, mobility, health, or other needs, please call 1-800-670-7773.
- Arrange accommodation for all members of the residence, if possible.
- Wait for an Evacuation Order to be issued before evacuating. Monitor [www.prrd.bc.ca](http://www.prrd.bc.ca) and Emergency Info BC for information on evacuation orders and location of Reception Centres and hours of operation.

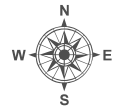
