



# PEACE RIVER REGIONAL DISTRICT EVACUATION ALERT

## EVACUATION ALERT #5 Red Creek and Stoddart Creek Wildfires Electoral Area B May 18, 2023 @ 19:30

An Evacuation Alert has been issued by Peace River Regional District at the Emergency Operations Centre (EOC). BC Wildfire Service has recommended an expanded evacuation alert as a result of the Red Creek and Stoddart Creek Wildfires. Because of the potential danger to life and health, Alert #5 replaces Alert #4.

The Peace River Regional District has issued an **Evacuation Alert** for the following areas:

- Rose Prairie, Montney, Coffee Creek, Prespatou, Altona, Peejay, Osborn, Mile 62 ½, and the East side of Highway 97 from Wonowon to Mile 120.

An Evacuation Alert has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

### WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Locate all family members and designate a meeting area outside the evacuation area, should an Evacuation Order be called while separated.
- Pack essential items such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit, and mortgage information), immediate care needs for dependents, cell phone & charger and, if time and space permits, keepsakes for quick departure.
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children and/or neighbours, if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets with you including pet care items (leash, carrier, food) and move livestock to a safe area (if possible).
- Arrange transportation for all your household members. Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles. If transportation assistance is needed, call [1-800-670-7773](tel:1-800-670-7773).
- Arrange accommodation for all members of the residence, if possible.
- Wait for an Evacuation Order to be issued before evacuating. Monitor [www.prrd.bc.ca](http://www.prrd.bc.ca) and Emergency Info BC for information on evacuation orders and location of Reception Centres and hours of operation.

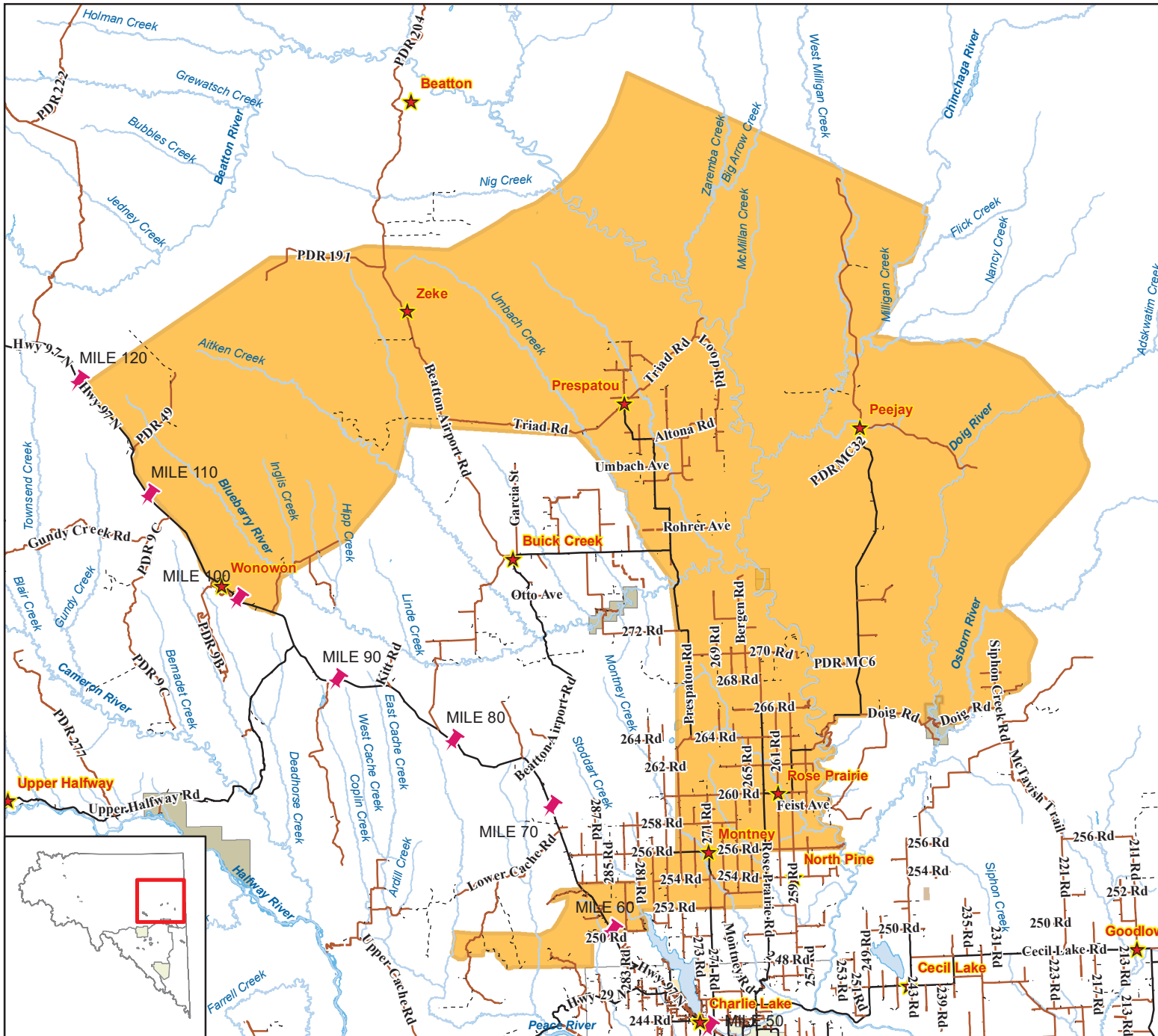

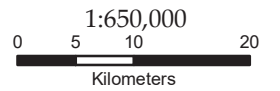
