Bylaw No. 2212, 2015

A bylaw to establish a potable water service in
Electoral Areas 'B', portion of 'C, and 'D' of the Peace River Regional District

WHEREAS pursuant to sections 796 and 800 of the *Local Government Act* the Peace River Regional District may establish and operate any service that the Board considers necessary or desirable for all or part of the Regional District;

AND WHEREAS the Peace River Regional District Board wishes to establish a service for the supply, treatment, conveyance, storage or distribution of potable water;

AND WHEREAS the Regional District Board has obtained the assent of the electors, in accordance with the *Local Government Act* and *Community Charter*;

NOW THEREFORE the Peace River Regional District Board, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. SERVICE BEING ESTABLISHED

The Peace River Regional District hereby establishes a service to be known as the "Potable Water Service" for the purpose of providing for the supply, treatment, conveyance, storage, or distribution of potable water.

2. SERVICE AREA

The boundary of the Service Area is defined in Schedule 'A', attached to and forming part of this bylaw.

3. PARTICIPATING AREAS

The participating areas are Electoral Areas 'B', 'C', and 'D'.

4. COST RECOVERY

As provided in section 803 of the *Local Government Act*, the annual cost of providing the Service shall be recovered by one or more of the following:

- (a) property value taxes imposed pursuant to the provisions of the *Local Government Act*, on the basis of the net taxable value of improvements only;
- (b) revenues raised by way of agreement, enterprise, gift, grant or otherwise; and,
- (c) revenues raised by user fees and other means authorized by the *Local Government Act* or another Act.

5. MAXIMUM REQUISITION LIMIT

In accordance with section 800.1(1)(e) of the *Local Government Act*, the maximum amount that may be requisitioned in any one year for the service is the greater of \$2,000,000, or an amount equal to the amount that could be raised by a property value tax of \$0.331/\$1,000 when applied to the net taxable value of land and improvements in the service area.

6. CITATION

This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Potable Water Service Establishment Bylaw No. 2212, 2015".

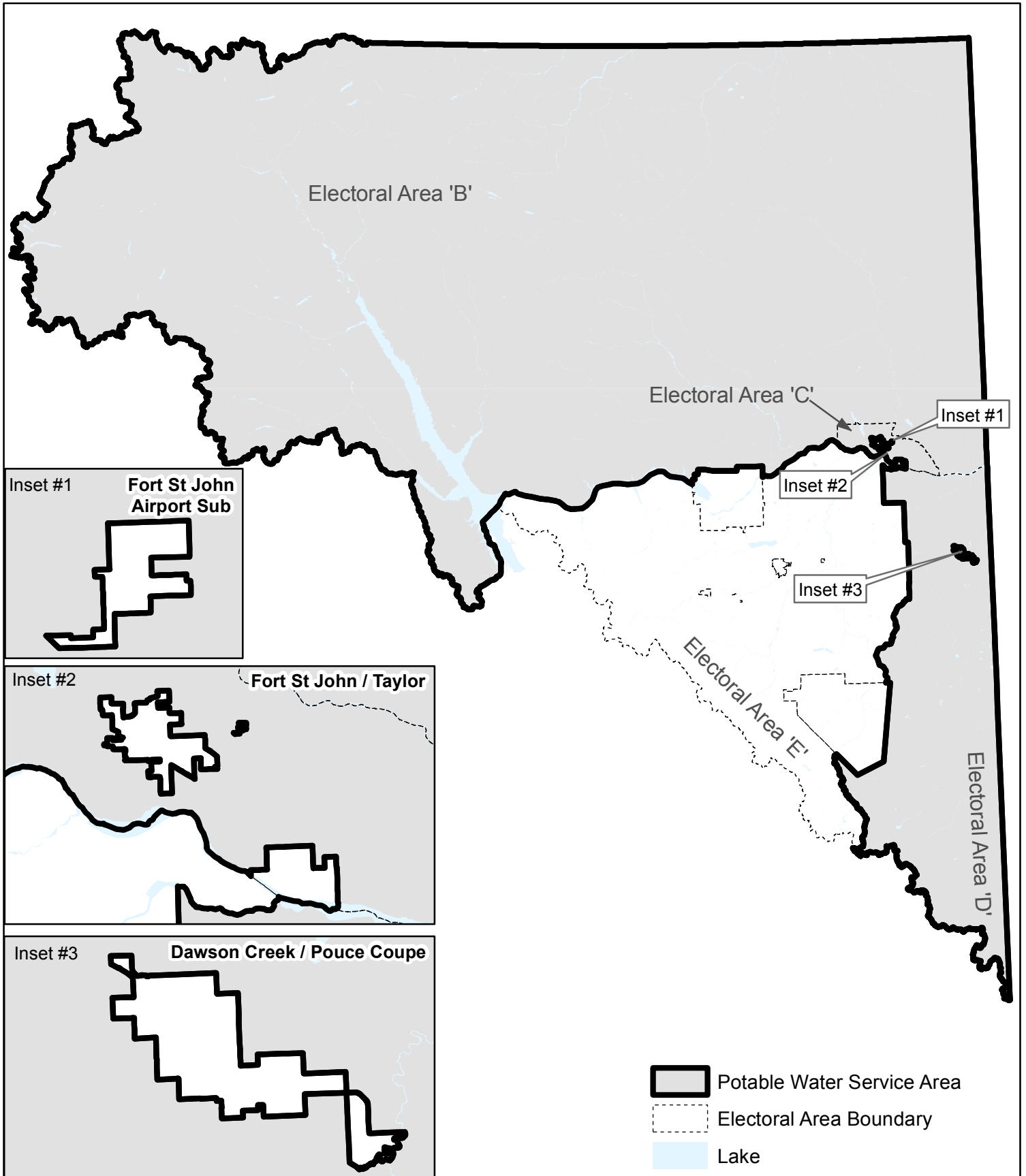
