Notice of Applications for Scrutineers and a Mail Ballot Opportunity Tate Creek Community Centre Service

On Saturday, September 9, 2017 qualified electors within the proposed Tate Creek Community Centre Service Area, will be voting on the following question:

“Are you in favour of the Peace River Regional District Board adopting “Tate Creek Community Centre Establishment Bylaw No. 2291 , 2017”, which will permit the Regional District to establish capital reserve and operating accounts to provide financial support for the operation of the Tate Creek Community Centre, at a maximum annual tax requisition limit that is the greater of \$90,000 (Ninety Thousand Dollars) or \$0.61 per \$1,000 calculated on the net taxable value of land and improvements and assessed on improvements only?”

Mail Ballot Voting

You may vote by mail if you:

- have a physical disability, illness or injury that affects your ability to vote in the conventional manner; OR
- expect to be absent from the Peace River Regional District on general voting day and at the times of all advance voting opportunities; OR
- reside further than fifty (50) kilometres away from the nearest voting place, as measured by road distance.

Requesting a Mail Ballot Package

Requests for a mail ballot package will be considered until the close of business August 25, 2017. Application forms are available at the Peace River Regional District office at 1981 Alaska Avenue, Dawson Creek and online at www.prrd.bc.ca/engage. To be counted, your mail ballot must be received by the Chief Election Officer at 1981 Alaska Avenue Dawson Creek before the close of voting on Saturday, September 9, 2017.
