RN/RPN Scholarship Program

The PRRD Registered Nurse/Registered Psychiatric Nurse Scholarship Program is currently accepting applications. The RN/RPN scholarship provides up to six students with a \$5000 scholarship to assist with their final year of study. Students must enter an agreement to work for two years with Northern Health in the Peace River Regional District. Completed applications are to be returned to the Regional District by October 31st, 2018.

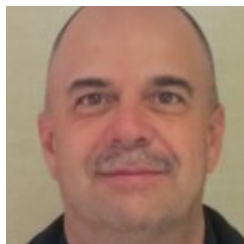

Old Fort Landslide

A landslide occurred in the evening between Saturday, September 29th and Sunday, September 30th in the Old Fort Area. The Peace River Regional District opened their Emergency Operations Centre, which remains open, to coordinate the emergency efforts. The area has been placed on Evacuation Alert, with a few properties under Evacuation Order.

Two meetings were held on October 2nd and another on October 8th for the PRRD and responding agencies to update the community on the emergency response.

Transportation has been arranged for residents to get to and from their homes by water taxi across the Peace River to the Taylor Boat Launch and bus service to Fort St John.

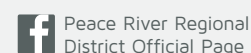
