June 25, 2015 Location: Hudson's Hope



### Committee of the Whole Meeting

Dave Conway and John Bodnarchuck from BC Hydro presented an update on the Site C project slated to start this summer. There will be Open houses held in Ft. St John, Taylor and Hudson's Hope in July. The first year's activities will include building roads, installing site security, finalizing the traffic management plan and to begin the procurement RFP process.

### Delegations

The North Peace Division of Family Practice presented to the Board what the funding that they provided to the group has been used for.

The aim of the North Peace Division of Family Practice is to improve the number of resident doctors recruited into the Peace Region (Dawson Creek, Chetwynd, Tumbler Ridge, Hudson's Hope and Fort St. John).

The PRRD funds have been distributed to resident doctors currently residing in the NE and resident doctors that wish to come to the NE to do their rural and elective rotations. Funding has gone towards monthly housing stipends, subsidizing housing costs, subsidizing exams costs for Resident Doctors residing in the NE and for those Doctors deciding to stay in the community for a minimum of 1 year incentive is awarded.

### Contract Awards

The Toronto Dominion bank was awarded a five year contract to provide banking Services for the Peace River Regional District.

Conestoga Rovers and Associates were awarded a \$190,498 contract for the design and contract administration of the Bessborough landfill.

### Zoning Amendment

Stanley and Deanna Dyck's zoning amendment application was adopted by the Board to allow them to rezone the property from A-2 (large Agriculture Holdings Zone) to R-5 (Residential 5 Zone) to allow for the subdivision of a 10 acre lot.

### New position at the PRRD

Trish Morgan has been promoted to the newly created position of General Manager of Community and Electoral Services.

### Agricultural Land Reserve Applications

The Gladysz, Willms, 0813983 BC Ltd, McLelland, Lucas, Green applications were forwarded to the ALR.

### Letters of Support

The Board authorized that a letter be forwarded to Kwadacha Nation in support of their funding application to Northern Development Initiative Trust to assist in purchasing furnishings and fixtures for the Community and Youth Recreation Centre.

The Board also authorized a letter be forwarded to Peace Region Internet Society in support of their funding application to Northern Development Initiative Trust to assist in extending fixed wireless high-speed internet services for Northern BC's Peace Region.
