The Electoral Area directors were approved attending the conference at the end of May in Salmon Arm.

2015 Recreation Trails Grants

The Regional Board approved the following 2015 Recreational Trails Grants-in-Aid application in the following amounts:

- Bear Mountain Nordic Ski Association \$21,375.00
- Northland Trail Blazers Snowmobile Club \$25,538.00
- Tumbler Ridge Snowmobile Association \$ 6,000.00
- Whiskey Jack Nordic Ski Club \$15,000.00
- Wolverine Nordic & Mountain Society \$ 6,750.00

Special Event Grant

The Regional Board approved a special event grant of \$5,000 for the Rotary Club of Dawson Creek to host the 2015 district conference in Dawson Creek from October 1 to 4, 2015.

The Berge and the Pederson applications were forwarded to the ALC.

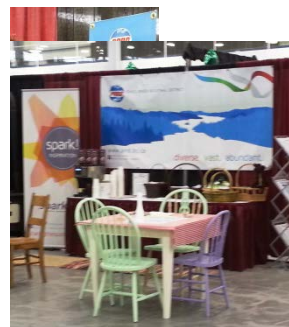
Northeast Strategic Advisory Group

The Northeast Strategic Advisory group was formed by the Province in 2014 to support implementation of the Cumulative Effects (CE) program in the Northeast Region. The Cumulative Effects program supports streamlined authorizations and reduces red tape, providing consistent, up front information and tools to project proponents and decision-makers to support decision-making in the natural resource sector, Director Goodings was appointed as a liaison to the Northeast Strategic advisory group and Chair Ackerman will be the alternate.

Charlie Lake Sewage Local Service Bylaw

The Charlie Lake Sewage Local Service Bylaw was adopted. This amends the Charlie Lake Local Service Area boundary and allows for operating and capital costs of the service to be recovered by way of a parcel tax.
