



Canadian Red Cross Old Fort Fridge/Freezer Replacement

If your fridge, or freezer was damaged during the Old Fort landslide evacuation in 2018, you may be eligible for support with replacement costs from the Canadian Red Cross and the B.C. Government. Financial assistance for spoiled food replacement is also available. Eligible homeowners who lost power during landslide evacuations can register with the Canadian Red Cross and be assessed for financial assistance with fridge, freezer, or food replacement by meeting with a Red Cross caseworker to discuss their needs.

Red Cross caseworkers are available for drop-in meetings with landslide impacted residents.

Please bring valid government-issued photo identification with your home address, proof of home ownership, and any receipts or invoices for your purchase costs if you have already replaced your fridge/freezer.
