Contract Awarded

The North Peace Leisure Pool Concession contract was awarded to Sher's Café for a one year period.

Development Variance Permit

The Regional Board passed a resolution to issue Mary and Scott Campbell a Development Variance Permit, to reduce the minimum permitted lot size of four(4) lots from 1.8 Ha (4.5 acres) to reflect the actual lot sizes of 0.14 Ha (0.35 ac) each, that were created in 1964. This will facilitate removal of a Crown condition of sale for consolidation on the basis that the proposal will result in no material change to the current conditions.

Emergency Communications Service Delivery

The Regional Board will provide feedback to the Ministry of Justice on the "Emergency Communications Service Delivery in British Columbia: Police Communication Centres and 911 PSAP – Strategic Vision Discussion Paper."

The Ministry of Justice is seeking feedback from stakeholders in the province on the future of emergency communications in BC. In particular, opinions are being sought on the amalgamation of Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) and Police dispatch, next generation 911 services (text to 911 and video to 911), and funding options for these services including a call answer levy (CAL).

Category 2 and 3 Open Fires Restricted

Effective Wednesday, May 13, 2015 (12:00 pm) all Category 2 and 3 Open Fires are prohibited in the Prince George Fire Centre Management Area until August 30, 2015 or unless otherwise notified. The Peace River Regional District is within this area.

Site C

A letter will be sent to BC Hydro in response to mitigation plans sent out for review. The Site C Clean Energy Project released an updated draft of the Vegetation and Wildlife Mitigation and Monitoring Plan for the PRRD to review. The Board reduced its original 39 detail-based concerns, to 11 broad-based recommendations. As the current draft plans are primarily focused on vegetation and wildlife resources, only a select few of the original concerns are being considered at this time.

- The Revised Vegetation and Wildlife Mitigation and Monitoring Plan
- The Del Rio Pit Development Plan
- The West Pine Quarry Development Plan
- The Wuthrich Quarry Development Plan

Bylaw Amendment

The Peace River Regional District Officers Establishment Amendment Bylaw No. 2205, 2015 was adopted. The Bylaw gives authority for the Corporate Officer to consolidate bylaws so that when the Board adopts amendments to bylaws, the original bylaw (or "parent" bylaw) may be updated to include the amendments so that they are all in one document and easily referenced.
