Making a Development Application

Description:

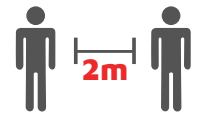
The Peace River Regional District manages [development applications](#), including [Building Permits](#), Land-Use Planning, Rezoning, Temporary Use Permits, Development Variance Permits, and more.

Peace River Regional District offices reopened as of June 1st with new procedures in place to follow Provincial Health Orders and keep residents and staff safe. Please follow these guidelines when proceeding with your development applications.



Procedures for Making a Development Application:

- 1** When visiting PRRD offices, follow Physical Distancing requirements and stay 2m / 6ft apart from others at all times.
Please follow the maximum occupancy posted outside each room and do not enter if the maximum occupancy has been reached.
- 2** When possible, consider contacting staff by phone or email rather than coming to the office. Email planning@prrd.bc.ca to reach our Development Services Department. Payments for applications can also be made over the phone.
Consider using the [PRRD online Webmap](#) for questions about your property.
- 3** Sanitize your hands as you enter and exit PRRD offices. Hand sanitizer is available through the doors for public use.
- 4** Public Hearings for development applications are currently on hold to comply with the Provincial Health Order restricting gatherings of more than 50 people. Public Hearings will be reinstated once restrictions are lifted.
