

COVID-19 Quick Reference Guide



Taking Items to PRRD Landfills and Transfer Stations

Description:

The PRRD owns and operates 3 landfills, 16 transfer stations and various unmanned transfer sites. Hours of operation can be found on the PRRD website.

Landfills and Transfer Stations sites remained open and operational during the COVID-19 Pandemic with new procedures to follow all Provincial Health Orders and maintain health and safety for staff.

PRRD Share Sheds were closed on March 28th and will be reopening as of June 15th with new procedures in place.



Procedures for Taking Items to PRRD Landfills and Transfer Stations:

- 1** Keep your distance. Follow Physical Distancing requirements and stay 2m / 6ft apart from others at all times, including in the parking lot and inside facilities.

A maximum of 1 person at a time is allowed in PRRD Share Sheds to ensure physical distancing.



- 2** Take precautions to manage your risk such as sanitizing your hands frequently and packing a 'Clean Trip Kit' that includes gloves and hand sanitizer.

Common surfaces, such as the transaction pad, continue to be sanitized between each use at manned sites. Please use hand sanitizer before completing transactions or entering the Share Shed.

It is recommended that items taken from Share Sheds are cleaned and sanitized before use.



- 3** Cash transactions are accepted using a combination of container and gloves to limit exposure risk. Please respect the barriers in place to protect workers and residents.
