



Using the Charlie Lake Sewer Receiving Facility

Description:

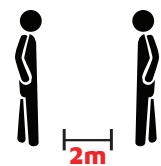
The PRRD owns and operates a sewer collection network and trucked waste receiving facility. While the collection network sees little to no interaction with the public, the sewer treatment facility services multiple trucking companies registered to haul wastewater.

Sites are signed for the public to respect physical distancing. Contractors work singly or travel separately where heavy labour is needed. Interactions with truck drivers are limited to only when they need help and support.



Procedures for Using the Charlie Lake Sewer Receiving Facility:

- 1** Keep your distance. Follow Physical Distancing requirements and stay 2m / 6ft apart from others at all times.
Contractors work alone or travel separately when labour is needed.



- 2** Take precautions to manage your risk such as sanitizing your hands frequently and packing a 'Clean Trip Kit' that includes gloves and hand sanitizer.
Regularly used surfaces (tables, Portalogic keypad, and pipe connections) are sanitized at least twice per day.
Please sanitize your hands before and after using equipment.
