EVACUATION ALERT

Kelly Lake

September 4, 2022 at 07:00hrs PST

An Evacuation Alert has been issued by the Peace River Regional District at the Emergency Operations Centre (EOC). BC Wildfire Service has recommended an evacuation alert as a result of the Bearhole Lake Wildfire (G72178).

Because of the potential danger to life and health, the Peace River Regional District has issued an **Evacuation Alert** for the following areas:

- The Community of Kelly Lake
- 4km West of the Alberta border
- From 5km North of Kelly Lake until 5km South of Kelly Lake

An Evacuation Alert has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions. A map of the evacuation alert area is provided below.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Locate all family members and designate a meeting area outside the evacuation area, should an Evacuation Order be called while separated.
- Pack essential items such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit, and mortgage information), immediate care needs for dependents, cell phone & charger and, if time and space permits, keepsakes for quick departure.
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children and/or neighbours, if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets with you including pet care items (leash, carrier, food) and move livestock to a safe area (if possible).
- Arrange transportation for all your household members. Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles.
- **Those with transportation, mobility, health, or other special needs can call 1-800-670-7773 for assistance.**
- Arrange accommodation for all members of the residence, if possible.
- Wait for an Evacuation Order to be issued before evacuating. Monitor www.prrd.bc.ca and Emergency Info BC for information on evacuation orders and location of Reception Centres and hours of operation. 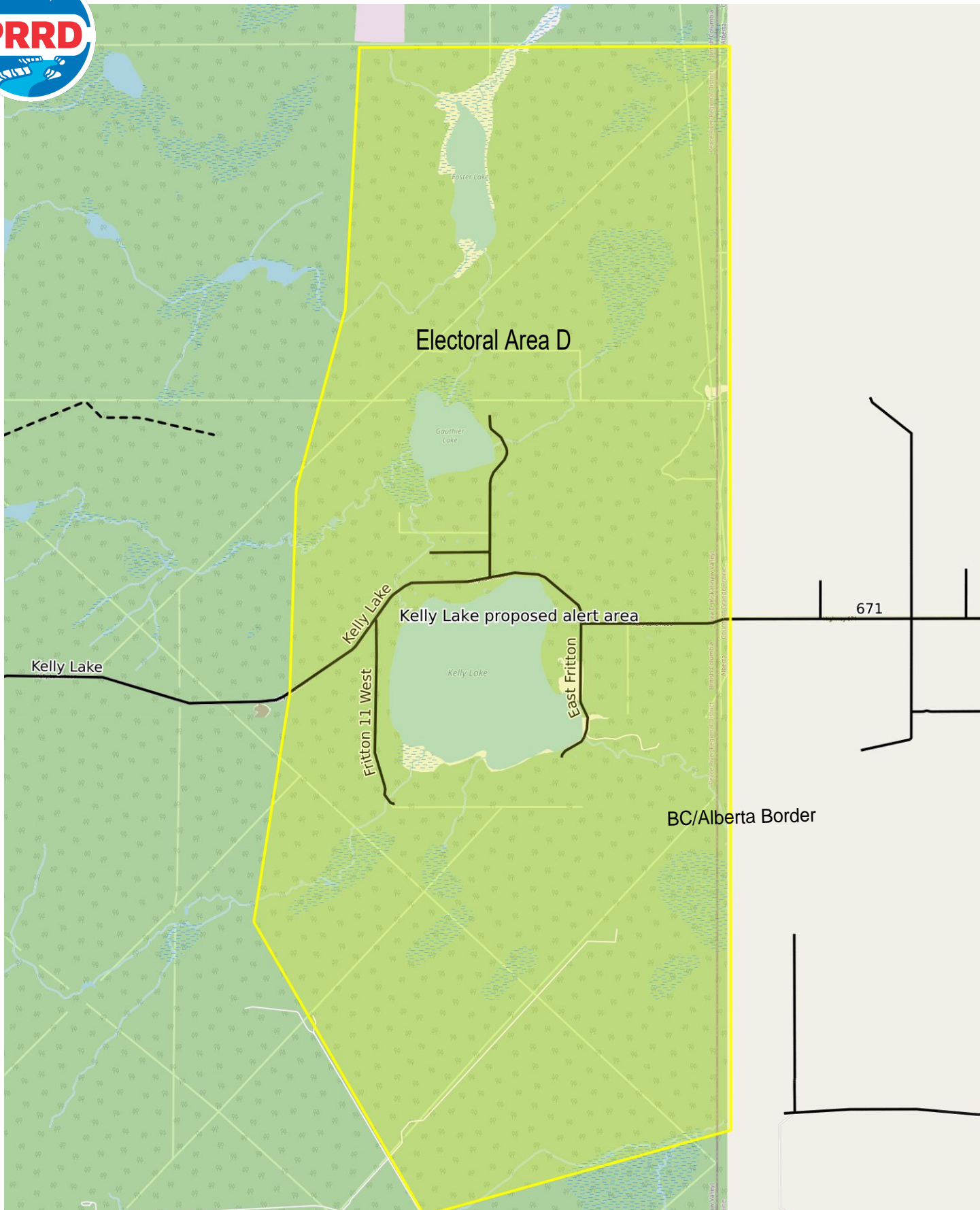
