



# PEACE RIVER REGIONAL DISTRICT EVACUATION ALERT #8

## OLD FORT LANDSLIDE EVACUATION ALERT ISSUED - **REVISED** August 12, 2020 at 1200 hours

An Evacuation Alert was issued by the Peace River Regional District effective October 10, 2018 at 0900 hours due to a landslide that occurred in the Old Fort area of Electoral Area C on Sunday, September 30, 2018. The landslide has continued to progress. The Evacuation Alert is being issued as a precautionary measure. **This evacuation alert has been revised to reflect the new road alignment following the June 18, 2020 landslide – please see map for details.**

The Evacuation Alert is for the properties East of 265 Road, south of 240 Road, west of City of Fort St. John boundary and 7583 Old Fort Road including the following properties:

- 9819 240 Road
- 6963 265 Road
- 6933 265 Road
- PID: 006-773-397
- PID: 007-387-539
- Road right-of-way south of 007-387-539
- Crown Provincial: REM SEC18 TP83 R18 W6M
- A portion of 7583 Old Fort Road
- A portion of 9820 River Drive
- A portion of 6975 Old Fort Road
- A 50 metre wide Right Of Way around the current location of the semi-permanent access road in N ½ of S ½ of SW ¼ SEC 19TP 83 R 18 W6M and N1/2 OF SW1/4 SEC 19 TP 83 R 18 W6M

An Evacuation Alert has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however, you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions. Please stay tuned to local media channels for information.

### WHAT YOU SHOULD DO WHEN AN ALERT IS IN EFFECT

Be prepared for an evacuation order by:

- Locating all family members or co-workers and designate a meeting area outside the evacuation area, should an evacuation be called while separated.
- Gathering essential items such as medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (i.e. insurance), immediate care needs for dependants and, if you choose, keepsakes (photographs, etc). Have these items readily available for quick departure.
- Preparing to move any disabled persons and/or children.
- Moving pets and livestock to a safe area.
- Arranging to transport your household members or co-workers in the event of an evacuation order. If you need transportation assistance from the area please call 1-800-670-7773 or 250-784-3200.
- Arranging accommodation for your family if possible. In the event of an evacuation, the Reception Centre at the Pomeroy Sports Centre will be opened if required.
- Monitoring news sources for information on evacuation orders and locations of Reception Centres.

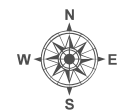

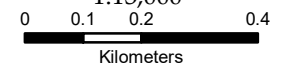


