## **Environmental Assessment Act (2018)**

- Amendments Section 32 of the Act
- Required when a Certificate Holder proposes to do something that has not been authorized by the EAC
- No legislated timeline
- EAO Policy guidance on Amendments (December 2020)



#### What the Amendment Process is Not

 Not reopening the decision on the original environmental assessment.

 Not reopening the Environmental Assessment Certification, beyond the scope of the amendment under review.



#### **EAO**

- Primary role: coordinates application review and prepares decision materials for decisionmaker
- Establishes procedures/timelines
- Fulfills Crown Obligations to Indigenous nations
- Determines adequacy of BC Hydro engagement with TAC/technical reviewers



#### **Certificate Holder**

- Primary role: Provides information about the proposed amendment
- Engages with Indigenous Nations
- Works with TAC members/technical reviewers
- Tracks and responds to comments
- Responds to public comments raised through the public comment period



#### **Indigenous Nations**

- Participate in government-to-government engagement
- Provide comments on the application/referral package
- Provide advice and information
- Participate in consensus seeking activities
  - Participating Indigenous Nations



## **Technical Advisory Committee**

- Primary role: technical review of the application
- Provides comments on the application/referral package
- Provides information and expert advice to the EAO
- Aids in issues resolution



## **Guiding Principles - TAC**

- Communications and information sharing
- Confidentiality
- Transparency
- Relevance



## **Key Questions/Considerations - TAC**

#### Potential questions:

- Has the technical analysis been adequately conducted? (e.g., appropriate methods, complete data)
- Any facts/technical matters requiring clarification/addition information?
- Is the application complete? (e.g., per legislative requirements met)
- Are appropriate mitigation measures proposed?
- Are the conclusions appropriate?
