## North Peace Leisure Centre Feasibility Study

The Board approved Area B and C participation in a feasibility study to review the costs and options to repair or replace the NP Leisure Centre. The Board will also ask the District of Taylor and the City of Fort St. John to fund and participate in the feasibility study.

## Tate Creek Community Centre Assent Voting

The final results for the Tate Creek Community Centre Assent Voting were declared on September 12, 2017. The referendum passed with a 62.4% Yes Vote and about a 26% voter turnout.

The Board adopted the service establishment bylaw for the Tate Creek Community Centre. This authorizes the PRRD to requisition a tax on homes in the area to fund the community centre service.

## Agricultural Land Reserve Applications

The Board approved the Giesbrecht and Keuth ALR subdivision applications to proceed to the ALC.

## Development Variance Permit

The Board approved issuance of a Development Variance Permit to the Smiths for an oversized suite at 911 Elk Ridge Drive.

## Solid Waste

The Regional Board directed staff to investigate service delivery alternatives for the provision of Solid Waste education and outreach services in 2018 and beyond. These options will be presented at the October 26, 2017 Board meeting.

## NDIT Grant Application

The Regional Board directed staff to submit an application to NDIT for a grant of up to \$8,000 to contract the services of a rural grant writer.

## CLFD Fire Prevention Week Activities

Fire Prevention Week is from October 8<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup>. This year the Charlie Lake Fire Department will celebrate Fire Prevention Week with the following activities:

**October 14 Open House and Barbeque** – Local residents are invited to come out to the Fire Hall from 11–2 meet the firefighters, walk through the fire hall, see the equipment and ask questions!

**Charlie Lake Elementary School Visits** – Charlie Lake Firefighters will be visiting the Charlie Lake School to provide a short presentation. This year's theme is "Every Second Counts, Plan 2 Ways Out."


## Fire Prevention Week Contest


